

WORKSHEET: CHAPTER 13

FORGIVING OTHERS DISCIPLINE OF OBEDIENCE

MEMORY VERSE:

Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

Colossians 3:12 - 13

OBEDIENCE IS WORSHIP

1. Obedience is faith.
2. Faith is confidence in who God proclaims to be.
3. Without faith, I can not have a relationship with God because I must believe, through word and deed, that God is who He says He is.
4. Proclaiming through my words **and** my deeds the reality of who God is, this is *true* worship.

OBEDIENCE IS ADORATION

1. Jesus tied obedience and love together in His relationship with the Father. (John 14:31)
2. Jesus tied obedience and love together in our relationship with Him. (John 14:15)
3. Obedience is the only way to proclaim my love of Jesus.

THE OBLIGATION OF DEVOTION: OBEDIENCE IS GRATITUDE

1. If someone saves your life, you owe that person your life.
2. Jesus, through His death and resurrection, saved your life.
3. Your life is no longer yours, it belongs to God.
4. Pay Him, through your obedience, what you owe Him - YOUR LIFE!

After you digest all of that, do a personal inventory. . .

pray , thank God for the blood of Jesus Christ and meditate on the cross

*journal, make a list of your personal relationships
note any individuals with whom you have any unresolved issues
note any individuals who have any unresolved issues with you*

***SHORT ACCOUNTS – immediately address anything that God brings to mind
do you need to ask for forgiveness? . . .do you need to forgive?***

ACT on God's Word

if necessary, invite a friend to hold you accountable

pray, thank God for the blood of Jesus Christ that has set you free!
