questions for an in-depth examination into your spiritual health

1. Name something God is currently working on in your life. Give an example of the fruit of that change. 2 Peter 1:5 – 8; John 15:1 – 17; Galatians 5:16 – 24
2. When someone sins against you, are you quick to forgive or do you hold onto the offense? Is there anyone in your life that you are unwilling to forgive? Matthew 6:5 – 15; Colossians 3:12 – 17; Luke 7:36 – 50
3. Do you follow through on your commitments – relational, spiritual, emotional, physical, financial? 2 Timothy 4:1 – 8; 1 Peter 4:1 – 11; Proverbs 3:9 & 10
4. Are you teachable? Do you submit yourself to other Christians out of reverence for Christ? Proverbs 5:7 – 14; 7:1 – 5; Ephesians 5; 1 Peter 3:13 – 25
5. Are you transparent? Do you live the same way in public as you do in private? Proverbs 4:23; 6:27 – 28; Acts 5:1 – 11
6. Are you generous with your resources – money, time, talent, opportunity – or do you hoard what you've been given? Philippians 2:19 – 30; 2 Corinthians 9:6 – 15; 1 Corinthians 12
7. Do you pray for your enemies? Do you seek ways to love them and serve them? Luke 6:27 – 36; Romans 12:9 – 21; Luke 23:26 – 43
8. Do you live with an eternal viewpoint, aware that everything in this life has to be seen in light of that everlasting perspective? 1 Timothy 6:11 – 21; 1 Corinthians 10:23 – 33; Hebrews 10:19 – 39
9. Do you work to promote your agenda or Jesus' agenda on this earth? Titus 2 and 3; Philemon; Deuteronomy 11
10. Do you fear man or do you fear God? How does that manifest itself in your life? Luke 12:4 – 7; Proverbs 9:7 – 12; Revelations 20:11 - 15
